



AL-DTMII Data Transfer Module



The AL-DTMII (Alarm Lock Data Transfer Module 2) is used to program multiple locks without the need to carry a laptop round with you to each lock.

The AL-DTMII can also be used to send and receive programming and log information to or from up to 96 locks before returning to PC running the DL-Windows application.

The DTMII is connected to the PC and the DL-Windows application sends programming for up to 96 locks into the AL-DTMII memory. The AL-DTMII is then disconnected and taken to each lock in turn and connected. A programming code is entered at each lock. Once the code is entered, the lock transmits its 'Door Number' to the AL-DTMII and the AL-DTMII sends the lock the required programming for that 'Door Number'.

Power Requirement: Battery – PP3 9V (Supplied)
