

Axxon Next 3.6.2 Release Notes

30.12.2014 AxxonSoft releases version 3.6.2 of Axxon Next video management software.

New features and improvements

- 1. Improvements in GreenStream. GreenStream is now compatible with cameras that have configurable profiles for streams, as well as the ONVIF and RTSP drivers (support for receiving multiple streams via the RTSP driver has been implemented in Drivers Pack v.3.2.28).
- 2. User rights regarding video archives can now be configured.
- 3. User rights for accessing cameras can now be changed on a group basis. When configuring a role, administrators can change access rights for all of a server's cameras.
- 4. Situation analysis detection tools are now color-sensitive.
- 5. Settings for the situation analysis detectors now allow controlling for camera shake.
- 6. When connecting to a server, users now receive a notification if the client version number is different from the server version number.
- 7. The Health Board now displays information about average recorded video per day for each camera.
- 8. New localization (Kazakh) added.
- 9. Product documentation has been corrected and supplemented.

Fixes

- 1. Error capable of causing incorrect saving of configuration settings has been fixed.
- 2. Error causing incorrect switching between video streams in detection tool settings has been fixed.
- 3. Error causing incorrect display of video from some fisheye cameras has been fixed.
- 4. Numerous errors related to archive functioning have been fixed.
- 5. Video buffering has been improved.
- 6. Issue affecting joystick control of PTZ cameras has been fixed.
- 7. Web client: in some cases the archive timeline was displayed incorrectly; this has been fixed.
- 8. Web server error preventing streaming of some cameras on multiserver systems has been fixed.
- 9. Several errors causing instability and memory leaks have been fixed.
- 10. Display artifacts for Tattile cameras have been fixed.





New version of iOS client

iOS client is updated to version 3.0. The version is available on the following page: https://itunes.apple.com/us/app/axxonnext/id578133893

Version 3.0 includes the following improvements:

- 1. Interface is completely redesigned.
- 2. Ability to move to the previous / next record fragment has been added.
- 3. Ability to quickly switch between Web servers using the drop-down list has been added.
- 4. Web server connection settings can now be transferred using QR code or email.
- 5. Minor bugs have been fixed and stability of the app has been improved.
- 6. Documentation has been corrected and supplemented.

The Axxon Next installer includes both the client and server components. The client can be installed on a computer together with the server, or installed on a separate dedicated client workstation. There is no limit on the total number of servers and clients in a system.

Axxon Next can be activated in one of three modes: paid, trial or free.

The free version supports 1 server, 16 cameras, 1 TB storage, and an unlimited number of clients.
