

the resident who has been called can converse with the caller. When called the telephone activates the display and enables speech for a fixed period (adjustable 30 - 120 seconds). An option is available whereby the lock release button will only release the door when the telephone has been called.

The telephone has a number of push-buttons clearly and permanently identified on the cover;

## Door

A momentary press of this button will provide a timed output to the lock release (adjustable, typically 5 seconds). A green LED indicator is included to show when the door is open (a N/O door contact is required for this function).




A resident may view the entrance at any time by pressing this button. This feature is only recommended on single way systems and should be disabled on all others.

This is used for multi-entrance systems to allow a tenant to monitor each of the entrances in turn.

To avoid disturbance from nuisance calls the resident may push this button to mute the call tone for a fixed period (adjustable between 1 minute and 10 hours). A red indicator lamp will illuminate when the telephone is muted.

If an 'audio only' telephone is required for extension purposes, a model 801 or any of the 500 DC models may be used. However, the model 500PLX is recommended since it includes many of the features of the Bellview video telephone.
