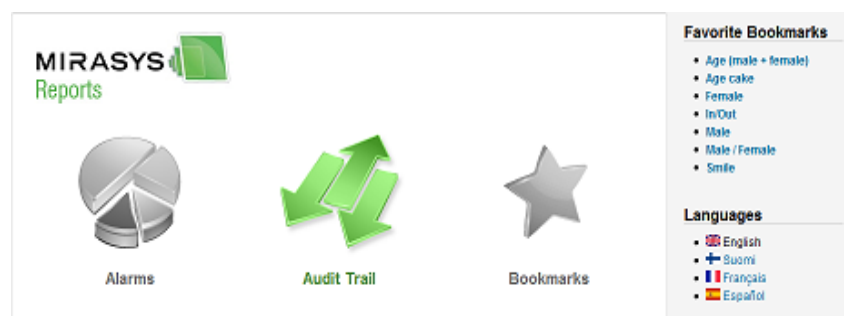
Alarm and event storage

Pre-configured reports can be accessed easily through bookmarks. Menu items can be hidden for specific end users.

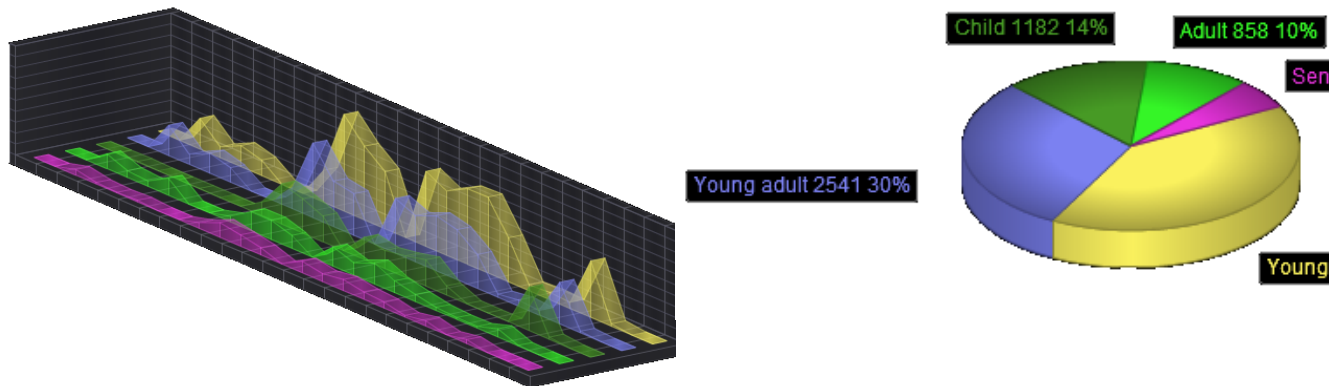

Event and alarm report variations



Both the reporting source data and specific graphs can be easily exported to Microsoft Excel, PowerPoint or Word as images or in list format. Preconfigured reports such as “how many people are currently in the building” (example: *event [person entered] minus [person left]*) can be stored as bookmarks and accessed with one mouse click.
