



Reporting features

Selective reporting of events, database and acknowledged alarms. Time recording report shows length of time spent in each area by each person. Presence report shows all people currently present, and their location. Special automatic reporting facilities are available in cases of emergencies, e.g. presence of all those currently on the premises.

Network features

Any workstation in the system may have Access Control Units (ACUs) connected to it. All Ultragard 'S' features may be accessed from any workstation (subject to user-defined restrictions).

Access control features

Allows programming of all features provided by ACU. All cards can be individually programmed for selected validity periods expiring automatically at a specified date/time.

Access monitoring features

Multiple-on-screen event windows display different event selections. Separate alarm window shows only those events which have been defined as alarms. Events can be cleared from this window by following alarm 'acknowledgement' procedures.
